Join us for a one-day FEE/Economic Thinking seminar on the economics, history, and politics of the federal income tax.

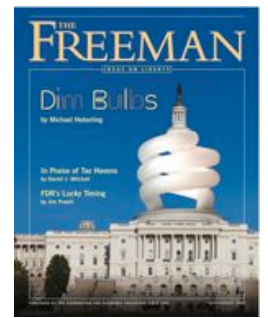
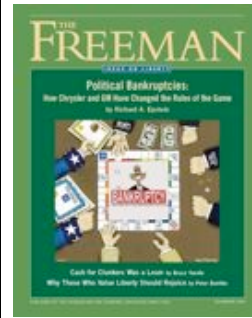

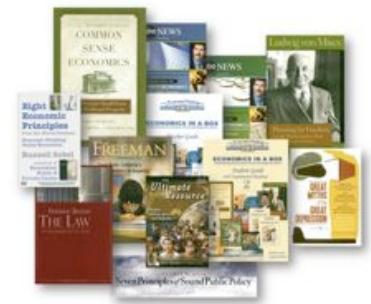
